



How to get to the networking venue?

Our venue this year is the Adria International School situated in Opatija, a charming town on the Kvarner Bay. It is located only 15 minutes away from Rijeka, so here are best suggestions on how to reach us.

ZAGREB

Zagreb is the capital of Croatia, located 160 km from Rijeka. Shuttle buses from Zagreb airport to the main bus station go every 30 minutes. It will take you about 20 minutes to the main bus station and another 2 hours by bus to Rijeka. You can see the bus schedule and ticket prices from Zagreb to Rijeka [here](#). There is also a direct connection from Zagreb Airport to Rijeka, but only at 3.30 PM – details [here](#).

PULA

Pula airport is located 7 km from the city centre with shuttle buses usually departing 30 min after the arrival of each flight. You can buy your ticket for the shuttle bus [here](#). You can travel to Rijeka by bus (tickets available [here](#)) or rent a car.

BRNIK, LJUBLJANA

Brnik airport is located 137 km from Rijeka. You can book a transfer to the centre of Rijeka [here](#). If you rent a car at the airport, you will have to buy a highway vignette for Slovenia.

TRIESTE, ITALY

Trieste airport is located 70 km from Rijeka, 2-3 hours by bus. The best option is to rent a car or to use Go-Opti.

VENICE

Venice Marco Polo or Treviso airport is located around 220 km from Rijeka. It takes approximately 3,5 hours by bus to get here. You can check the prices and book a bus from the airport straight to Rijeka centre [here](#).

Once you reach Rijeka, you need 15 more minutes by taxi or 30 minutes by local public bus (number 32) to reach Opatija.
